

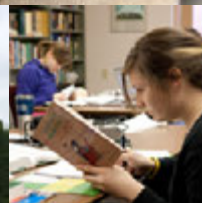

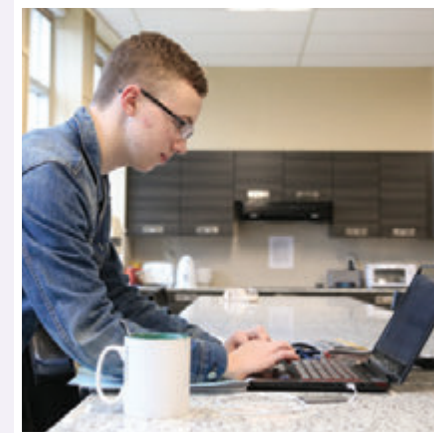

Who We Are

Thorneloe University is a partner of the Laurentian University federation. Located in Sudbury, Ontario, Canada Thorneloe offers programs in Ancient and Classical Studies, Religious Studies, Theatre Arts, Motion Picture Arts, and Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies, with degrees granted through Laurentian. Affiliated with the Anglican Church of Canada, Thorneloe University is home to a School of Theology, granting degrees, diplomas, and certificates in theology. The Thorneloe campus includes a classroom building, 150-seat theatre, a residence of 58 single rooms, and a multi-use chapel/classroom.

Strategies

PRIORITY #1 – STRENGTHEN ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

To achieve this priority, Thorneloe University will:

1. Invest in faculty, including professional learning, program development, and research
2. Expand online and distance education through innovative teaching strategies and technology
3. Strengthen academic alliances with Laurentian University, Cambrian College and other key partners

PRIORITY #2 – ENHANCE VISIBILITY AND INCREASE ENROLMENT IN ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

To achieve this priority, Thorneloe University will:

1. Improve communications, marketing, recruitment, stakeholder relations, alumni relations, partner engagement, and fundraising
2. Develop and implement communications and fundraising plans with measurable goals and outcomes
3. Intentionally recruit students into academic programs (majors, minors, concentrations, specializations, and School of Theology degrees, diplomas, and certificates)

PRIORITY #3 – REVITALIZE SPACES FOR LIVING, LEARNING, AND WORKING

To achieve this priority, Thorneloe University will:

1. Conduct an external audit of all facilities, including the student residence
2. Develop a plan for enhancements
3. Make strategic investments

PRIORITY #4 – FOSTER WELL-BEING AND HONOUR DIVERSITY, INCLUSION, AND RESPECT

To achieve this priority, Thorneloe University will:

1. Adopt policies, procedures and practices to ensure a safe, welcoming, accepting, and inclusive environment that nurtures well-being
2. Effectively communicate policies, procedures, and practices and monitor for compliance
3. Develop and implement strategies that promote wellness and community

PRIORITY #5 – GOVERN WITH EXCELLENCE

To achieve this priority, Thorneloe University will:

1. Recruit Board members based on required skills
2. Provide training in partnership with Laurentian University
3. Focus on sustainability and continuous improvement
